



BRICS Seminar on Energy Storage Technologies

22 April 2021

The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Government of India hosted a virtual BRICS Seminar on Energy Storage Technologies (EST) on 22 April 2021. Delegates from BRICS countries representing respective Governments, industry and businesses participated in the Seminar. Seminar had three distinct sessions.

Representatives from Governments presented EST status, technological and deployment outlook in respective countries and detailed opportunities for BRICS cooperation. In the industry session importance of business to business collaboration for exploring market in BRICS countries was underlined.

The Panel discussion highlighted key technological issues specific to BRICS countries and deliberated upon the possible areas of cooperation in research, product development and manufacturing. It emerged that unique expertise of BRICS countries provide ample opportunities for strategic cooperation on EST which could help accelerate the transition to climate friendly clean energy. The delegates also under lined the need for exchange of information on different aspects of energy storage technologies.

The BRICS delegates appreciated the need and requirement of Energy storage and agreed upon exploring opportunities for collaborative approach on technology, manufacturing, business prospects and extended their cooperation and support for future partnerships.
