



BRICS Working Group Against Corruption (WGAC) Lecture Sessions on “Harnessing Technology to combat corruption”

As BRICS Chair 2021, India organized a two-day interactive lecture Series (4 sessions) for BRICS countries’ experts on the theme of “Harnessing Technology to combat corruption” in collaboration with Indian School of Business, Hyderabad in online format on 26-27 August 2021. Four sessions were held on themes of (i) Business and Ethics (ii) Role of Emerging Technologies in combating Corruption (iii) Corruption or Government Effectiveness & (iv) Role of Technology to combat Crime and Corruption in Infrastructure and Government.

BRICS countries participated in and appreciated the interactive lecture sessions on Harnessing technology in combating corruption. India’s priority of “Minimum Government Maximum Governance” was highlighted by discussing the technological transformations of its public services, evidence-based-data-driven policy making, deepening of digital identity systems to strengthen delivery of incentives.
